

L'infinitif, les conjugations, et des verbes

Grammaire: L'Infinitif

In English, the infinitive is the most basic form of a verb. It is: "to" + the verb <u>example</u>:

to run, to dance to speak

In French, an infinitive does not have the equivalent of the word "to" in front of it. Rather, each verb has an ending. All infinitives end in one of three endings. The endings are:-ER, -IR, -RE Example: manger, finir, vendre
